

### Dear Church Family,

Yesterday I attended a one day conference on church multiplication, the theme of the day was 'missionary discipleship', giving a focus both to being with Jesus and being sent out by Jesus. Like any conference, there were some outstanding moments and some moments when I realised I'd tuned out and was more interested in checking WhatsApp and sports scores! By the middle of the afternoon I realised my brain was full, I'd heard five or six people telling us what they thought "the most important thing to focus on in your church is...." I tuned out and instead of tuning into WhatsApp and cricket scores, I tried to tune into the voice of the Holy Spirit. "Lord, what is the most important thing for us at St Chads at the moment?"

Attempting to answer that question is one of the most important things I do as leader of St Chads. (much more important than WhatsApp and even more important than cricket!) I realised I had too many potential answers in my head and realising that itself caused the Holy Spirit to guide me back to three things I sensed from God. Firstly, the call I shared at our vision Sunday, to give God space. If there is too much going on in our heads, it's a good sign that we need to create space to be still with God. Secondly, a sense to carry on what he has already given us to focus on: Glorifying God, Loving Community and Following Jesus, these capture a life which is God-orientated and prayerful, which is soaked in love and building community and moving forwards in the direction Jesus is calling us to. Thirdly, to create some space in the diary with Katie and Dave to discern together what God is calling us to focus on as a church family in the autumn.

When we consider listening to God and creating space for him, I want to highlight two ways we're doing that in July. The first is our Original Design Evening, which is in church on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July. Some of you will have done original design evenings in the past, if you are newer to St Chads we haven't done one for a while. It's a low-pressure environment to have a go. They are a really beautiful way to practice listening to God for words of encouragement and identity for others in a relaxed joyful yet deep way. I absolutely love them!

The second is our 100 hours of prayer in Sanctuary from 7am on 16<sup>th</sup> July to 11am on 20<sup>th</sup> July. I would love to encourage everyone in St Chads to commit to signing up to spend an hour in prayer in Sanctuary during those days and nights. The Sanctuary is the very heart of the LifeCentre and St Chads and a place to meet with God. As I have prayed about what it means to give God space, he keeps calling me back time and again to this invitation to spend time with him and for Sanctuary to be a place of encounter. I'll share more below, but I urge you to join in with this, it isn't a special thing for a few keen people, this is an invitation for you.

### The Bishops are coming to visit!

All three of our Bishops (Chester, Stockport and Birkenhead ) are coming to visit our area on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> July. The Church of England is arranged with parishes (the area one church serves, in our case Romiley) which are grouped with 10-20 other churches in its area called a deanery. Bishops Mark, Sam and Julie are visiting our deanery on those dates. They want to meet people of all ages and talk about Jesus with those who don't know him and encourage and connect with those who do. They will be visiting schools, businesses, community groups and church ministries which are meeting on those dates, (including RPS, EarlyLife, the LifeCentre and Mini-Chadders).

Bishop Mark will be leading and preaching at our Wednesday Communion on 2<sup>nd</sup> July at 11am and we'd love to invite you to join our regular Weds communion congregation that week. Mark is an inspirational and godly man, well worth listening to.

There will also be a **worship service** for the whole deanery at **All Saints in Marple on Tuesday** 1<sup>st</sup> at 7.30pm, which will include interviews with Mark and Sam, who will be sharing both personally and about the wider vision of the Chester diocese. As an Anglican church, we are part of a much larger movement of God at work in our region and we hope this evening will inspire us in our faith, unite us with other local Christians and inspire us to share Jesus in our community. It would be great to have a good crowd from St Chads to bring our joy, love and passion for Jesus into that occasion.

Sanctuary is always available for that when the LifeCentre is open, but we are setting things up to make it available through the nights too. There will be a sign up sheets in church and online, we can't guarantee sole use of the room, but the focus is quiet space with God, except at the gathering times.

Unlike previous blocks of prayer, we are keeping this one simple. The prayer stations for our Easter prayer room were amazing, this time however is about space with God. If you've never spent an hour in a prayer room in prayer it can seem like a challenge, but I am sure you'll find it powerful and be so glad you did! We'll provide a simple resource available to use if the idea of an hour in prayer feels daunting, it will give you a bit of shape and guidance if that's helpful.

As we pray in there through 100hrs I believe the rich, powerful sense of God's Presence in there will grow deeper and stronger. It's hard to articulate in a letter like this just how much I sense a passion that God is calling us all to give him an hour of our time over those four days and inviting us to meet with him. So please put something in your diary and join in with this. The Creator of the Universe is inviting us to spend time with him, that's worth making a priority.
