FOLLOW UP QUESTIONS FOR HUBLETS OR ALONE.

Start with a really quick personal memory test:

- If alone: Name 3 truths from Living Free which you've embraced.
- In Hublets go round and each name 1 key truth from LF so far.

On the Cross - Jesus was separated from the Father. Richard placed a strong emphasis on sin and brokenness being rooted in separation from God. How have you experienced separation from God leading to brokenness and sin.

What examples of the 'childish' and 'adolescent' myths have you seen in films, books, TV shows, conversations, newspaper articles you've come across recently?

Why can emphasis on: social forces, genetics and childhood trauma lead us into a 'victim mindset'?

Is there anything from that list in your life, which has too much influence, which God is calling you to leave behind today?

Are you teachable?
Where and when are you willing to admit you've got it wrong?
