The Electoral Roll is the official membership list of St Chad's, as set out by the rules of the Church of England.

Every six years, the old roll ceases to exist, and everyone needs to complete a new form to come on to the new roll.

2019 is the year for full renewal of the roll.

So, if you are 16 or over and live in the parish OR if you live outside the parish but worship with us regularly, we ask you now to complete and sign a form to come on to the new roll.
